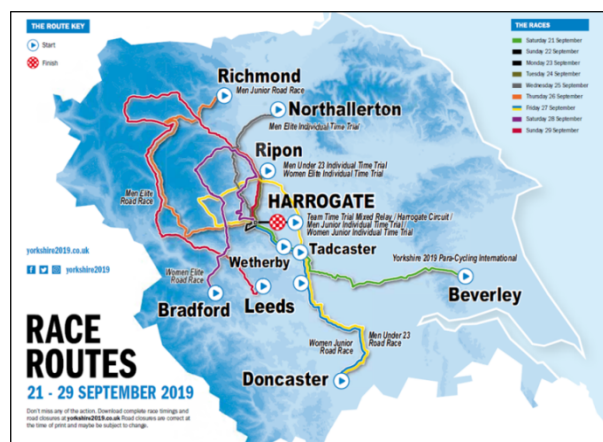


**YORKSHIRE 2019 UCI WORLD CYCLING CHAMPIONSHIPS**

In September 2019 the world’s best cyclists will come to Yorkshire for the UCI Road World Championships, the pinnacle event in the international road cycling calendar. The Championships will include a range of men’s and women’s races, across age groups from junior to elite, starting in different towns and cities throughout Yorkshire and each finishing in the main competition town of Harrogate (please see right).



Harrogate will be the focal point for the Championships and host the finish of every race over the nine days of competition. Racing will take place throughout the **21<sup>st</sup> – 29<sup>th</sup> September 2019**.
