Why?

If you are worried about your child's physical development please visit one of our 'Drop-In' Sessions.

The sessions are run by a qualified Physiotherapist and a Physiotherapy Assistant. They will be able to talk to you about any concerns you may have about your child's physical development.

What to expect at the session?

The Drop-in clinics are open sessions where other children and parents may be present. They are held in local children centres and there will be access to toys and play equipment.

You may have to wait to be seen, depending on how busy it is.

The physiotherapist will ask you questions about your child's development and will observe/assess your child while they play.



What will happen next?

The Physiotherapist will share ideas with you on how to help your child. If the physiotherapist decides that a more detailed assessment is required, you will be offered an individual appointment with a member of the children's physiotherapy team. There may be a short wait for this. You and your child may be asked to attend 'Drop-In' again to see how they are progressing.

After the session, you will receive a written report which summarises the outcome of your visit. Copies of this will be sent to your child's GP and Health Visitor, with your consent.


