


There were not enough people at this meeting to make any decisions.

Eyes and Ears symbols


• All wards and the Emergency Department have these symbols.


 Christine Thompson said that further changes would be made to the Patient Voice Group noticeboard.



 Bob Tunnicliffe asked about the Equality training again and Geoff Marshall said that the training would be changing.




 Andrew Newton asked if any Equality issues had been reported in the Harrogate Hospital Care Quality Commission report. Angle Colvin said that there were no issues.
