## Confidentiality and electronic information sharing

We respect and maintain patient confidentiality at all times. We only share relevant information between the teams that have a responsibility for a patient's care, such as hospital and hospice staff, GPs and community staff, in order for them to do this in the best possible way. This can be shared electronically, by letter, or verbally. If patients do not wish their information to be shared, they can talk to their nurse.

In exceptional circumstances where either patients or others are at risk of serious harm, we may have an obligation to share information they have asked us not to.

All patients are discussed at a weekly team meeting to ensure the best possible way of managing pain, symptoms or other issues.



Palliative Care is the care of patients with advanced, progressive, lifelimiting illness. The aim is to achieve the best possible quality of life by managing the effects of the disease through good pain and symptom management, as well as practical and emotional support

#### Who are we and what do we do?

We are a team of nurses and doctors employed by Harrogate and District NHS Foundation Trust. We have specialist knowledge in palliative care and look after patients with life-limiting illnesses such as cancer, heart failure and advanced lung disease.

We visit patients in wards and outpatient departments at Harrogate and District Hospital, in nursing/residential homes and in patients' homes in Harrogate and the surrounding district.

We work closely in conjunction with GPs, consultants and multiprofessional teams who have overall responsibility for patient care. We aim to complement the care they are already providing to manage symptoms and to enhance quality of life. We also work closely with Saint Michael's Hospice.
