## **Patient Advice On Contact Lens Wear**

## **Insertion of lenses**

- 1. Wash and dry hands
- 2. Remove from storage case and rinse with saline or multipurpose solution
- Dispose of solution in case (never 'top up'), rinse with saline or multipurpose solution and air-dry
- 4. Ideally keep lens case dry when wearing contact lenses

## **Removal of lenses**

- 1. Wash and dry hands
- 2. Fill storage case with fresh sterile ...... solution (vented case for peroxide)
- **3.** Remove lens from eye
- 4. Apply a few drops of ..... to lens
- Rub lens in palm of hand for 60 seconds (30 seconds each side of lens)
- 6. Rinse thoroughly with saline or multipurpose solution
- 7. Replace lens in case

## **Compulsory Aftercare**

- Attend hospital contact lens appointment at least every 6-12 months
- Check-up to identify potential problems (that could affect the health of your eyes) early on, before you even become aware of them
- Attend having worn your lenses for at least 3 hours that day
