Membership Development Strategy

The Group will review the complete Development Strategy each year and a review was initiated at the meeting. Amendments will be reported to the Council of Governors in a timely manner when they arise. It was decided to keep the Membership target number at 17,500 and this will be reviewed in 2016.

Following a suggestion from our new Stakeholder Governor, Mrs Parker, Mrs Colvin met with Maternity colleagues and they will include membership leaflets in their patient information packs.
