- Maternity Pads (large pack)
- Toiletries Shampoo, shower gel, deodorant, toothbrush, toothpaste, face wipes
- Hairbrush & Hairbands
- □ Lip Balm
- Snacks & Drinks
- Water bottle
- □ Music to listen to in labour if you would like
- If being induced, bring something to read or watch e.g. magazines
- □ Going home outfit

- □ Change of clothes
