



Fuel Poverty Information Fact Sheet - Harrogate/Craven District

What is fuel poverty? Living in a property with an energy efficiency rating of band D or below and when spending the required amount to heat the home, residents are left with a residual income below the official poverty line.

There are 3 important elements in determining whether a household is fuel poor:

- · Household income
- · Household energy requirements
- Fuel prices

Predicted impact on people living in North Yorkshire: households across the region will face a record energy increase of 54% from April 2022. Warm and Well in North Yorkshire is warning that many more families will be pulled into fuel poverty and the worst is yet to come. This means that households who pay by direct debit will face an average of bill of £1,971 a year for their gas and electricity.

Living Well have put together this fact sheet to support workers to provide information to people to manage the impact of fuel poverty.
